and Keynote Address

This year's keynote will be delivered by designer, author and speaker, Fu-Tung Cheng. Known mostly for his innovative technique of using natural concrete for counter tops, Mr. Cheng has studied at UCLA, in Japan, and earned his Bachelor of Arts degree at the University of California, Berkeley. In 1975, he purchased his home in Albany, just north of Berkeley and began a 25-year-long "experimental renovation" that continues to define and inform his hands-on, timeless green design. Mr. Cheng will also be presenting one of the hour-long educational sessions later in the morning. ~ 1/2 CE credit is available for the keynote address.
